

**Notes:**

1. All students are required to take one of the following microeconomics courses:

<b>ECON 2103 Principles of Microeconomics [3 credits]</b>	For students without Economics background or those scoring: - DSE Economics: 2 or below - IB HL & SL Economics: 4 or below - AP Microeconomics: 2 or below
<b>ECON 2113 Microeconomics [3 credits]</b>	Students scoring: - DSE Economics: 3 or above - IBHL Economics: 5 & 6 - IBSL Economics: 5 or above - AP Microeconomics: 3 & 4
<b>Students with other qualifications should contact your Academic Affairs and Advising Counselor (AAAC) for the course placement.</b>	

2. For Macroeconomics, students who enroll in the BSc in Economics and Finance are required to take ECON3123, instead of ECON2123.

3. For students admitted in 2015/16 or before, BBA in Global Business students are required to take LABU 2050 for graduation and all remaining students are required to take LABU 2051 & 2052 for graduation.

4. Students admitted in 2016/17 or after are required to take LABU2040 and LABU2060.

5. Students are required to take one of the following mathematics courses based on the pre-admission qualifications:

6. Special attention for students who would like to select BSc in Quantitative Finance:

Students who would like to enroll in the BSc Quantitative Finance (QFIN) must take *MATH 1012 OR MATH1013 OR MATH 1020 OR MATH 1023*. Students who take *MATH 1003* cannot pursue the QFIN program.
